- **88 one-day** domestic service centers in North America



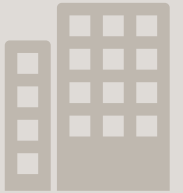

Ocean Freight:

- Service on over 2,300 direct lanes
- Handle nearly any size shipment including FCL, LCL, special equipment and oversized cargo, all with the option of port-to-door service
- LCL service access to trading partners responsible for 97% of the world GDP
- Access to almost every major ocean liner service transiting the world's waterways
- Process for managing over 600,000 20-foot equivalent unit (TEU) containers worldwide



Multi-Modal Services:

- Range of special UPS Preferred multi-modal freight services to bridge the speed and economy gap
- UPS Preferred LCL to North America is our service from Asia and Europe origins that leverages our truck networks in the United States, Canada and Mexico. It accelerates shipments to their final destinations enabling savings of up to 70% versus air freight costs while providing up to 45% faster transit times versus standard LCL ocean movements
- UPS Preferred FCL and LCL-Rail services the Europe-China markets to deliver savings up to 65% versus air freight costs while providing up to 40% faster transit times versus standard ocean movements
- UPS Preferred Sea/Air combines ocean and air freight on some of the world's longest trade routes to deliver savings up to 35% over air freight while providing up to 55% faster transit times than standard ocean service

Customs Brokerage:
